It can be frustrating when your child ignores you or just acts silly when you've asked him or her to do something. Sometimes my child just needs a little help getting started. To share the work and make it more manageable, you might race to pick up toys or move like robots, or sing a song while working.

When you're finished, say, God wants you to do your work like you are working for Him. I think He is pleased with how you worked to clean up.

Try This:

I look for ways to encourage persistence with a task by noticing when my child colors or plays with blocks for an extended period of time (how long varies for each child depending on age and abilities). After a time, I say, You stayed focused on your activity and for a long time. Good job!
