Amongst all the new setup of the school, we do hope that this will bring our school into a better environment for the children to learn in.
















First Day of School

The first day of school went smoothly, as everyone was eager to come to school, ready to learn and explore.



ISMILE Preschool recognizes the value of parents' involvement in their children's education. To foster cooperative relationships between parents and teachers, the school conducts the Parents' Orientation Day. On July 21, 2023, ISMILE Bandung had the Virtual Parents' Orientation Day. It was well attended by parents, who were all eager to take an active role in their children's education. The discussions centered on introducing the teachers, the ISMILE Framework and programs, the updated health and safety procedures, and StoryPark-a new platform for parents and teachers to use in communicating and keeping up with the progress of the kids. At the perclass level, benchmarks and other concerns were also discussed.

The orientation was successful in its goal of informing and clarifying for parents the key issues surrounding their children's education. Indeed, the Parents' Orientation Day is a fantastic chance to inform parents about what to anticipate from the children's learning adventure this semester.

From July 10 to July 13, an enriching and empowering teachers' training program took place at ISMILE Permata Hijau.

The day began with a thorough discussion about our school's framework, where teachers engaged in insightful conversations and exchanged ideas. We also learned about the Montessori approach, exploring principles and methodologies the that underpin this innovative approach. The afternoon session took a delightful turn as a fun-filled game session was organised as part of the character-building program.

The second day was a captivating experience, conducted by our coordinator, Ms. Fem. The focus of the day was on a Reggio Emilia-inspired approach. Teachers learned how to create thoughtfully designed and aesthetically appealing spaces that can stimulate children's interests. The concept of provocation was also explored, emphasizing the importance of presenting open-ended







questions and materials to encourage critical thinking and problem-solving skills. Project work was also highlighted to encourage in-depth investigations and collaboration among students. We also discussed the importance of documentation as

a tool to reflect on the learning process.

The third and fourth days of teachers' training at ISMILE Permata Hijau were filled with valuable and practical learning experiences.

Teachers split into groups based on levels for targeted discussions about the curriculum and lesson plans. These focused sessions allowed teachers to exchange insights, challenges, and successful strategies in the classroom.

On the fourth day, a comprehensive training session on first aid kits was conducted, complete with live demonstrations and hands-on practice.

We also had a discussion about the Storypark app. It provided the teachers with a cutting-edge tool to digitize and enhance the student's learning process, creating an accessible platform for







parents to stay involved in their child's educational journey. The session introduced the app's user-friendly features, allowing teachers to easily document and share students' progress, achievements, and activities in real-time.

With the aim of nurturing a dynamic and inclusive learning environment, the fourday training sessions at ISMILE Permata Hijau left an indelible mark on each participant, equipping us with the knowledge and tools to inspire the minds of the future generation.
